



Promote camp opportunities


Networking with other scouting units

Booths for other groups like NYLT, Woodbadge, summer camp, wilderness first aid ect


Recruit cub scouts to our troop

Would be willing to serve on staff.


What kinds of demonstrations do you think your unit might do at a Scout-O-Rama?




Would you be interested in doing an outdoor activity display?




What would you think is a fair price to pay for a Scout-O-Rama ticket for one person? (Choose one)




If you could buy a 'Family Pass' for your whole family (2 adults, 2 kids), how much would you pay?




What timeframe do you think would be the best time of year to hold a Scout-O-Rama? (check all that apply)
